Last week, a new patent from Google showed the company was working on a third-party keyboard for its upcoming mobile OS, iOS. Apple's iOS already has numerous third-party keyboards that let users type on their mobile devices using not their own hardware, but instead a keyboard on their computer. This, of course, was only a patent, and a small one at that. But now that the new iOS 6 beta has been released, a third-party keyboard is beginning to look more plausible. When the first iOS 6 beta was released, many assumed it would be the last time Apple would release iOS to the public. And as a result, some people, like the iPhone developer Ben Krasnow, assumed this would be the last beta release for iOS. But it seems he was wrong, and this new iOS 6 beta isn't the last. In fact, if iOS 6 had been released and iOS 7 was already on the way, you can bet that an iOS 7 beta, even a final one, would have been released in the last few weeks. And it looks like the same will be the case for iOS 6. The first thing to note is that when Apple released the first iOS 6 beta, it only included a few major features: namely, it had bug fixes for the Apple Maps app, the Safari browser, and the Settings app. Most people saw this as a sign that iOS 6 was not the major new version of iOS that they expected. But now, after Apple released iOS 6 in its first beta form, it's clear that while iOS 6 does contain bug fixes, there are a few important new features to expect. Will iOS 6 and iOS 7 be radically different? With iOS 6, Apple introduced a new notifications system called Reachability that makes it easier to access notifications from the lock screen by tapping on specific areas of the screen. It also added a new 3D touch feature, which lets users interact with an app by simply pressing down on the screen to get more information, or just to dismiss a notification. f3e1b3768c
