

What is Spider-Man 3? The Amazing Spider-Man 3 (or simply The Amazing Spider-Man 3) is a 2007 superhero film based on the Marvel Comics character Spider-Man. The film is the third in the Spider-Man film series, which began with 2002's Spider-Man and 2006's Spider-Man 2. It was directed by Sam Raimi and was produced by Marvel Studios. The film was released on May 2, 2007 in North America, and May 4, 2007 in the United Kingdom. Plot The film begins with New York City being ravaged by a supervillain led by Doctor Octopus. Doctor Octopus uses an experimental device to turn everyone on the planet into telepathic beings, which allows him to control their minds. The effects are not permanent. Spider-Man is assisted by Nick Fury and the Avengers. The vigilante Spider-Man finds that he cannot save everyone, but he can save himself. It is seen that Peter Parker (Tobey Maguire) is watching the events in New York, not knowing what is happening, Peter's Aunt May (Sally Field) is showing him his fashion model portfolio and Peter is emotionally and physically hurt because he believes that his life is meaningless, his life is thrown into chaos when Spider-Man's nemesis, the Green Goblin (Nathan Drake), attacks and steals Peter's car. Peter is saved by Spider-Man and they fight, but Doctor Octopus arrives and defeats Spider-Man. Spider-Man is taken to the hospital and May and Peter follow. Peter is taken to be treated by Doctor Octopus's experimental device, where the device is accidentally opened, causing the effects to last longer. As Peter is being treated, he is reunited with his girlfriend Mary Jane Watson (Kirsten Dunst). Peter leaves and Mary Jane stays to help Doctor Octopus. Peter arrives at Mary's apartment and asks her to go with him, but she refuses
