

Category:Engineering statistics Category:Statistics booksA man has been charged with more than 300 offences including assault, fraud and forgery after allegedly scamming the state out of \$5.6 million in unemployment benefits. David Beniowski, 68, allegedly applied for over 1,500 jobs over three years with four different employers. He was also accused of forging more than 10,000 job application forms. Police said the alleged fraud happened over a period from October 2012 to June 2015. A statement from WA Police said the alleged scam was 'exceedingly sophisticated' and would have required a considerable amount of planning and resources. It said Beniowski was hired by five different companies, initially as a part-time job, and was provided with references from current employees. "Following Beniowski's hire, the employment companies would ask the Australian Workplace Agencies for a references check on the job applicant," the statement said. "The AWAs would contact the references provided by the employment company and verify their identity and the accuracy of their reference. "The AWAs would then relay the results of their investigation back to the employment company which would then usually terminate the employment arrangement." Beniowski allegedly used the data on the job application forms to create fictitious references. Police allege he forged more than 10,000 application forms in the process. The statement said Beniowski made his first attempt to apply for a job with Work Australia in October 2012 and was employed as a part-time employee at a caravan park. He allegedly forged a job application form and gave a false reference from someone he had never met. "He was sacked immediately by the employer and, over time, he applied for more than 1,500 different part-time jobs and was employed in approximately 300 different companies," the statement said. "He continued to apply for jobs with a number of companies despite the fact that it was apparent that he was employed." Police allege Beniowski used the money from his alleged fraud to build properties around Perth and buy a Ferrari. "The fraud was conducted so cunningly and involved so many different aspects that it is difficult to imagine how Beniowski was not caught out sooner," the statement said. It said the investigation revealed Beniowski's fraud would have cost the WA economy more than \$5.6 million. Police said Beniowski was arrested at

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
