By 1988, AutoCAD was released to the public, and in September 1989, the first beta was made available. In April 1990, the first commercial version, AutoCAD II, was released. The first AutoCAD release included a regular price option and the commercial version was available for US\$4995 (today \$5500) CAD (US). Initially, AutoCAD, which cost US\$9,995, could only produce 2D drawings, but in 1994, AutoCAD Extended was released. This added features such as 2D and 3D modeling. AutoCAD 2D and later AutoCAD Extended continued to be developed for AutoCAD versions 16.0 through 2005. The use of the word "extended" as opposed to "2.0" was used due to the fact that several new features were introduced. For example, there were many 3D modeling improvements and several new 2D drafting capabilities were included. In 2005, the AutoCAD 2D product line was separated into separate 2D and 3D products. This occurred because the core market for the 2D product line had shifted to the 3D product line. In 2005, the 3D portion of AutoCAD 2D was released as AutoCAD Architecture. Many of the

Isozymes in cancer cells. Two-dimensional polyacrylamide gel electrophoresis (2-D PAGE) allows the analysis of thousands of proteins in a single gel. As a first step towards applying this methodology to cancer, we have used 2-D PAGE to investigate whether cancer cells contain isozymes not present in normal cells. For both cancer cell lines and patient samples, we have observed changes in the expression of several proteins not detectable in normal cells. For example, some proteins in cancer cells appear to be in a different configuration or form from normal cells, and others have altered pI values. Thus, 2-D PAGE of cancer cells appears to be a useful complement to other techniques for the detection of new proteins and of changes in the expression of proteins that occur during tumorigenesis.

The role of public education in the prevention of HIV infection. HIV infection prevention has been given high priority in the U.S. and in other Western countries for the last 25 years. Although the U.S. Centers for Disease Control has not formally recommended systematic HIV testing for adults (the need for which is questioned), HIV testing has been recommended for the prevention of HIV infection in the health care setting in health-related and public health settings, and by groups such as employers and primary care physicians. The health care setting, health care professionals, and employers have made significant progress in promoting voluntary HIV testing, but the public education campaign to promote HIV testing in the public and private sectors has met with limited success. There is a need for more education to prevent HIV infection by testing and providing condoms and other prevention strategies. Public education campaigns and systematic programs are needed in high-risk groups.
